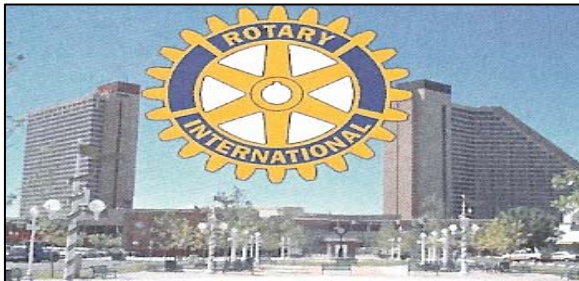

DISTINGUISHED NEVADAN

Chuck Fulkerson ('58 agriculture UNR), executive director of the Nevada Office of Veterans' Services (NOVS), was named a Distinguished Nevadan by the Nevada System of Higher Education's Board of Regents. It is the highest award presented by NSHE to those who have contributed to the state's cultural, scientific or social advancement. He will be honored during the spring commencement at the University of Nevada, Reno on May 20.

Fulkerson has been involved with the nation's military since 1955, when he joined the Army Reserve as a University of Nevada, Reno student. He served in the Army Reserve, completing two tours of duty in the Vietnam War and served in the Nevada Army National Guard. Fulkerson retired from active service in 1991.

After six years, Fulkerson is resigning his position as executive director of NOVS, effective March 31. During his term as executive director, Fulkerson oversaw the construction of the Nevada Veterans Nursing Home in Boulder City, Nev. and the continued improvement of the Veterans Cemeteries there and Fernley, Nev.
